



Scholarships for students with Discretionary Leave to Remain in the UK – Guidance Notes

Please read the following notes before completing the application form.

The University of Sussex has created two scholarships to help two students who would not otherwise be able to access Higher Education, to gain a degree at the University of Sussex. The award comprises a fee waiver and £3000 in cash paid in three instalments in each year the award holder is studying full time at the university.

Eligibility Criteria

In order to be considered for this scholarship you must meet all of the following criteria:

- Have been granted Discretionary Leave to Remain in the UK;
- Are not eligible for funding from Student Finance England;
- Have a household income below £42,620;
- Have been offered a conditional or unconditional place on an undergraduate degree programme at the University of Sussex;
- Have not previously obtained a degree or degree equivalent qualification from another Institution or country.

Once we receive your application we will contact you asking that you provide proof of eligibility.

This will include:

- Copies of documentation confirming your DLR status (letter or DLR card)
- Proof of your household income (P60's, payslips etc.)

Assessment Criteria

Applications will be assessed on the following criteria:

- Your and your family's history;
- Your ambitions;
- Your household income;
- Why you chose Sussex and how you intend to use your time here.

Timeline

- 30 June 2015 – close of applications
- 31 August 2015 – notification of outcome to applicants
